Act No. 56, 1975.

An Act to amend the definition of “Metal” and “mineral” in section 4 (1) of the Mines Inspection Act, 1901, so as to include substances obtained for use by councils or county councils. [Assented to, 9th October, 1975.]

BE

Mines Inspection (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by **No. 56, 1975**
and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in
Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Mines Inspection Short title.
(Amendment) Act, 1975".
