## Act No. 9, 1904.

## An Act to authorise the appointment of a Deputy MASTER IN EQUITY Master in Equity and to prescribe his powers and duties. [4th Norember, 1904.]

**D** E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the "Master in Equity (Deputy) Short title. Act, 1904."

2. The Governor may appoint a person to be Deputy Master Appointment of in Equity for any period, and may extend such period: Provided that <sup>Deputy Master</sup>. such period or extended period shall not exceed two years from the commencement of this Act.

**3.** During such period or extended period, the Deputy Master Powers of Deputy in Equity (whether the Master in Equity is absent or not), may exercise <sup>Master.</sup> any powers and discharge any duties which a Master in Equity may exercise or discharge, but only in those cases in which the present Master in Equity has been professionally concerned.
