Marriage with Deceased Wife's Sister Legalizing.

An Act to declare valid the Marriage of a MARRIAGE WITH Man with the Sister of his Deceased Wife. SISTER LEGALIZING. $\lceil Reserved - 21st\ July,\ 1875. \rceil$

THEREAS doubts have arisen in New South Wales as to the Preamble. validity of the marriage of a man with the sister of his deceased wife and it is expedient to remove such doubts Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. Every marriage otherwise lawful which has been heretofore Marriage with or which shall be hereafter celebrated within the Colony of New South deceased wife's sister Wales between any person and the sister of his deceased wife shall be deemed and is hereby declared to have been and to be valid and of full force and effect any law or custom to the contrary notwithstanding.
