An Act to amend the provisions relating to long Elizabeth II, service leave contained in the Public Service No. 21, 1957, (Amendment) Act, 1919, the Irrigation Act, 1912, the Main Roads Act, 1924, the Government Railways Act, 1912, the Transport Act, 1930, and the Police Regulation Act, 1899, and certain other Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 29th April, 1957.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:--

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Service and short title. Other Statutory Bodies (Extended Leave) Act, 1957".
- 2. The Public Service (Amendment) Act, 1919, as Amendment of amended by subsequent Acts, is amended by omitting Act No. 43, 1919. from subsection one of section thirteen the words "and sec. 13. up to a total service of forty years in all".

3. The Irrigation Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Amendment of Acts, is amended by omitting from subsection one of 1912. section 5c the words "and up to a total service of forty Sec. 5c. years in all''.

4. The Main Roads Act, 1924, as amended by subse-Amendment of quent Acts, is amended by omitting from subsection one Act No. 24, 1924. of section 7a the words "and up to a total service of Sec. 7a. forty years in all".
