## No. XV.

An Act to amend the Law with reference to the Collection of Toll or Ferry Dues on Parish Roads. [20th September, 1854.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales Preamble. by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

So much of the eighth section of the Act of Council passed in So much of 2 Wm. the second year of the reign of His late Majesty King William the IV. No. 12 sec. 8 as Fourth and numbered twelve as enacts that no Toll or Ferry Dues Roads repealed. shall be demanded or taken for or in respect of any carts drays or wagons carrying manure shall be and the same is hereby repealed so far as the same applies to the Toll or Ferry Dues to be demanded or taken upon any Parish Road now or hereafter to be established.
