SUPPLY ACT.

Act No. 21, 1940.

George VI. No. 21, 1940. An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Unemployment Relief Fund, the Social Services Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, towards the services of the Year 1940-1941. [Assented to, 27th September, 1940.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to your Majesty the sum of Seven millions six hundred and sixty-seven thousand two hundred pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of Two millions seven hundred and ninety-two thousand six hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one.

Out of the Unemployment Relief Fund, the sum of One million and sixty-six thousand five hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the services to be provided for out of the Unemployment Relief Fund during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one.

- Out of the Social Services Fund, the sum of Four hundred and twelve thousand one hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the services to be provided for out of the Social Services Fund during the mouths of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one.
- Out of the Government Railways Fund, the sum of Two millions five hundred and thirty-eight thousand five hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one.
- Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the sum of One hundred and four thousand six hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one.
- Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Six hundred and thirty-four thousand seven hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one.
- Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Forty-six thousand four hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways during the months of October

and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one.

Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, the sum of Seventy-one thousand eight hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one.

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said Funds the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

£2,792,600 may be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund. 1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Two millions seven hundred and ninety-two thousand six hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1940-1941.

£1,066,500 may be issued out of the Unemployment Relief Fund. 2. Out of the Unemployment Relief Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of One million and sixty-six thousand five hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty, to defray the expenses of the services to be provided for out of the Unemployment Relief Fund during the months of October

and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1940-1941.

£634,700 may be issued out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund.

Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Six hundred and thirty-four thousand seven hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways, during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1940-1941.

£46,400 may be issued out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund.

7. Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Forty-six thousand four hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Road Transport and Tramways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1940-1941.

£71,800 may be issued out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund. 8. Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Seventy-one thousand eight hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty, to defray the salaries,

maintenance

maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1940-1941.

9. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums Treasurer for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such to pay under proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders Warrant in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Unemployment Relief Fund, the Social Services Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, respectively.

10. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to Treasurer time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by to have him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And the receipts to receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall discharge be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

11. This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act, 1940." Short title.
