SUPPLY ACT (No. 2).

Act No. 34, 1928.

George V. An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1928-1929, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 7th December, 1928.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Three millions eight hundred and thirteen thousand pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund the sum of Two millions seven hundred and sixty-six thousand pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine.

Out of the General Loan Account, the sum of One million and forty-seven thousand pounds for the Services set forth in Schedule A hereto annexed:

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said Funds and the General Loan Account the sum so granted to His Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent

consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New £2,766,000 South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied may be issued out of the for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be Consolidated granted to His Majesty, the sum of Two millions seven Fund. hundred and sixty-six thousand pounds, to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1928–1929.
- 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Audit Act, £1,047,000 1902, there shall and may be issued out of the General maybe issued out of the Loan Account and applied for or towards making good General Loan the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty Account. the sum of One million and forty-seven thousand pounds for the Services specified in Schedule Λ hereto annexed.

3. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums Treasurer for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such pay under Governor's proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders Warrant or in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Order. Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and the General Loan Account respectively.

4. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to Treasurer to time be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by have credit him in nursuance of such Warrants or Orders. him in pursuance of such Warrants or Orders. And to discharge the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same him. shall be so paid shall be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

5. This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act (No. 2), Short title. 1928."
