SYDNEY CORPORATION (ELECTION OF MAYOR) ACT.

Act No. 61, 1915.

George V, An Act to provide for the election of the Lord Mayor of the City of Sydney; and to amend the Sydney Corporation Act, 1902. [Assented to, 22nd December, 1915.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Sydney Corporation (Election of Mayor) Act, 1915."

It shall be construed with the Sydney Corporation Act, 1902.

Election of Lord Mayor. 2. If the aldermen of the City of Sydney fail to elect a Lord Mayor on or before the thirtieth day of December in any year the Governor may appoint some member of the council to be Lord Mayor.
