

SYDNEY CORPORATION
(ELECTION OF MAYOR) ACT.

Act No. 61, 1915.

George V, An Act to provide for the election of the Lord Mayor
No. 61. of the City of Sydney; and to amend the
Sydney Corporation Act, 1902. [Assented to,
22nd December, 1915.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—

Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the “Sydney Corporation
(Election of Mayor) Act, 1915.”

It shall be construed with the Sydney Corporation
Act, 1902.

Election of **2.** If the aldermen of the City of Sydney fail to elect
Lord Mayor. a Lord Mayor on or before the thirtieth day of December
in any year the Governor may appoint some member of
the council to be Lord Mayor.
