

No. XXXVII.SYDNEY RATE.

An Act to enable the City Commissioners to levy a City Rate for the current Half Year and to regulate the amount of such Rate for the next succeeding Half Year. [18th December, 1855.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to fix the amount to be collected by the Commissioners of the City of Sydney for the current half of the present year and the first half of the ensuing year Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Rate of 4d. in the pound on present assessment for current half year

1. The Commissioners of the City of Sydney shall for the general purposes of the said City collect as soon as convenient for the now current half year a rate of four-pence in the pound on the whole of the property in the said City according to its present assessed value.

and of 3d. in the pound for first half year of 1856.

2. The said Commissioners shall collect a rate of three-pence in the pound for the same purposes for the half year commencing from the first of January next.
