

TOTALIZATOR (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 17, 1952.

An Act to amend the Totalizator Act, 1916-1937, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 12th September, 1952.] Elizabeth II,
No. 17, 1952.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Totalizator (Amendment) Act, 1952." Short title,

(2) The Totalizator Act, 1916, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Totalizator Act, 1916-1952.

(3) This Act shall commence upon a day to be appointed by the Governor and notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

2. The Totalizator Act, 1916-1937, is amended—

- (a) (i) by omitting from subsection one of section eight the word “ten” and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “twelve and one-half”;
- (ii) by omitting from paragraph (a) of subsection two of the same section the word “five” and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “seven and one-half”;
- (iii) by omitting subparagraph (iii) of paragraph (b) of the same subsection;
- (iv) by omitting from the same paragraph the word “two” and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “four and one-half”;

- (b) by omitting the proviso to subsection three of section ten and by inserting in lieu thereof the following proviso:—

Provided that it shall not be necessary to pay any fraction of a sixpence unless such fraction amounts to or exceeds threepence, in which case threepence shall be paid.
