Act No. 22, 1979.

An Act to amend the Traffic Authority Act, 1976, to increase the membership of the Traffic Authority and for certain related purposes; and to deem certain acts and proceedings of the Authority not to have been invalidated by reason that certain persons have acted as members. [Assented to, 24th April, 1979.] Act No. 22, 1979.

Traffic Authority (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Traffic Authority Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1979".

2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), this Act shall Commencecommence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Sections 3 and 4 and Schedule 1 shall commence on such day as may be appointed by the Governor in respect thereof and as may be notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

3. The Traffic Authority Act, 1976, is amended in the manner Amendment of Act No. 32, 1976.

4. Any act or proceeding of the Traffic Authority of New Certain South Wales before the date of commencement of this section shall acts or proceedings be deemed not to have been invalidated by reason that the Chief of the Commissioner of the Public Transport Commission of New South Traffic Authority Wales, or a person authorised by him to act as a member of the not in-Authority on his behalf, a representative of the Transport Workers' validated.
