Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Apiaries Regulation 2013* to exempt beekeepers from having to be registered under the *Apiaries Act 1985* if they are registered under the *Animal Diseases Act 2005* of the Australian Capital Territory and comply with certain conditions.

This Regulation is made under the *Apiaries Act 1985*, including sections 6 and 50 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Apiaries Amendment (Registration Exemptions) Regulation 2017*.
