1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Administrative Arrangements (Administration of Acts—Amendment No 5) Order 2018*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Allocation of the administration of Part 5B of the Local Land Services Act 2013

- (1) The administration of Part 5B of the *Local Land Services Act 2013* is allocated to the Minister for Lands and Forestry.
- (2) The allocation made by this clause replaces any previous allocation of the *Local Land Services Act 2013* to the extent that it is inconsistent with the allocation made by this Order.
