Explanatory note

The object of this Rule is to amend Part 28, rule 8 of the *District Court Rules 1973* to require expert reports to be served in accordance with that rule in all proceedings before the Court. At present, the rule applies only to proceedings in which damages are claimed in respect of the death of a person or personal injury or in which the Court has directed that the rule is to apply to proceedings.
