## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the principal Regulation as a consequence of the repeal of certain offences relating to registration and vehicle standards by the *Motor Traffic Amendment (Law Revision) Regulation 1998*. Offences relating to these matters will be located instead in the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 1998*, along with the short descriptions for those offences.

This Regulation is made under section 145B of the Justices Act 1902.

fraudulently alter/use/lend licence

Section 7 (c)—fraudulently allow a licence to be used by any other person

allow other person to use licence
