Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to facilitate the issue of penalty notices and legal process for certain offences under Part 3A (Provisions relating to light rail vehicles) of the *Motor Traffic Regulations 1935* by prescribing short descriptions by which those offences may be sufficiently stated.

Part 3A is inserted in the *Motor Traffic Regulations 1935* by the *Motor Traffic Amendment (Light Rail) Regulation 1997*, made at the same time as this Regulation.

This Regulation is made under section 145B of the *Justices Act 1902*.

Regulations 56H, 129—stop light rail vehicle so that rear end of vehicle within 30 metres of children’s crossing or marked footcrossing	stop light rail vehicle near children’s crossing/ marked footcrossing
Regulations 56J, 129—fail to avoid path of light rail vehicle at intersection	not avoid light rail vehicle
Regulations 56K, 129—fail to move vehicle or animal out of path of light rail vehicle	allow vehicle/animal obstruct light rail vehicle
Regulations 56L, 129—pass light rail vehicle otherwise than on own left-hand side	pass light rail vehicle on right
Regulations 56M (1) (a), 129—overtake light rail vehicle being at or near centre or right-hand side of carriageway otherwise than on its left-hand side	overtake light rail vehicle on right
Regulations 56M (1) (b), 129—overtake light rail vehicle being at or near left-hand side of carriageway otherwise than on its right-hand side	overtake light rail vehicle on left
Regulations 56M (2) (a), 129—overtake on left-hand side of light rail vehicle turning left or signalling intention to turn left	overtake left turning/signalling light rail vehicle on left
Regulations 56M (2) (b), 129—overtake on right-hand side of light rail vehicle turning right or signalling intention to turn right	overtake right turning/signalling light rail vehicle on right
