Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are:

- (a) to provide short descriptions for offences relating to the Roads Act 1993, and
- (b) to repeal short descriptions of offences relating to the *Roads (Weight of Loads on Main Roads) Transitional Regulation 1993* and the *Roads (Weight of Loads on Roads other than Main Roads) Transitional Regulation 1993*, both of which have been repealed.

This Regulation is made under the *Justices Act 1902*, including section 145B.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Justices (Short Descriptions of Motor Traffic and Other Offences) Amendment (Road Transport) Regulation 1997*.

Section 112 (3)—fail to comply with the terms of a notice indicating weight restrictions applicable to certain roads, bridges, causeways and road-ferries	breach weight limits for road/bridge/causeway/road-ferry
Section 235 (2)—be the owner of a vehicle in respect of which an offence under section 112 (3) is committed	owner vehicle breach road/bridge/causeway/road-ferryweight limit
Section 235 (2)—be the person in charge of a vehicle in respect of which an offence under section 112 (3) is committed	person in charge vehicle breach road/bridge/causeway/road-ferry weight limit
