The object of this Regulation is to prescribe the Societas Europaea with the corporate name James Hardie Industries SE as a continuation of James Hardie Industries NV for the purposes of the *James Hardie (Civil Penalty Compensation Release) Act 2005*.

This Regulation is made under the *James Hardie (Civil Penalty Compensation Release) Act 2005*, including the definition of **James Hardie Industries NV** in section 3 (1) and section 14 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *James Hardie (Civil Penalty Compensation Release) Regulation 2010*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Definitions

(1) In this Regulation:

the Act means the *James Hardie (Civil Penalty Compensation Release) Act 2005*.

(2) Notes included in this Regulation do not form part of this Regulation.

4 James Hardie Industries SE is prescribed continuation of James Hardie Industries NV

The Societas Europaea with the corporate name James Hardie Industries SE (and registered as a foreign company under the Corporations Act with that name and ARBN 097 829 895) is prescribed as a continuation of James Hardie Industries NV for the purposes of the definition of *James Hardie Industries NV* in section 3 (1) of the Act.
