

THREATENED SPECIES CONSERVATION ACT 1995 No 101

Notice of Final Determination and Amendment of Schedule 1 to Act

The Scientific Committee constituted under the *Threatened Species Conservation Act 1995* has, in pursuance of Division 3 of Part 2 of that Act, made a final determination to insert the following species of animal in Schedule 1 to that Act (Endangered species) and, accordingly, that Schedule is amended as set out in Annexure "A" to this Notice:

Amphibians

Hylidae

Litoria booroolongensis (Moore, 1961)

Booroolong Frog

The final determination to insert this species in Schedule 1 has been made because the Scientific Committee is of the opinion that this species is likely to become extinct in nature in New South Wales unless the circumstances and factors threatening its survival cease to operate.
