Commencement

1. This Ordinance commences on 1 February 1992.

Amendment

2. Ordinance No. 34C under the Local Government Act 1919 is amended by inserting after clause 7 the following clause:

Penalty notices—prescribed amount

8. For the purposes of section 270s of the Act, the prescribed amount of penalty for an offence under this Ordinance is \$45.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Under section 270s of the Act, offences against Ordinance No. 34C (e.g. standing in a free parking area provided by a council for longer than the maximum period allowed or standing in a space designated for use by disabled persons) may be dealt with by penalty notices. The object of this Ordinance is to prescribe \$45 as the amount of penalty for such an offence if dealt with by penalty notice.
