EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to remove from Schedule 2 (Statutory bodies) to the Public Finance and Audit Act 1983 the reference to the Insurance Premiums Committee which was abolished by the WorkCover Legislation (Amendment) Act 1989.
