EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Proclamation provides for the commencement on 1 February 1992 of all the provisions of the Workers Compensation (Benefits) Amendment Act 1991 except for:

- (a) an amendment to the amount of excess that certain employers are required to repay to their insurers in respect of claims paid; and
- (b) a further amendment consequential on that amendment.
