I, Rear Admiral PETER ROSS SINCLAIR, A.C., Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the Health Legislation (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 1994, do, by this my Proclamation:

- (a) appoint 1 July 1994 as the day on which Schedule 3 to that Act, and section 4 in its application to that Schedule, commence;
- (b) appoint 1 September 1994 as the day on which item (1) of the amendments to the Psychologists Act 1989 in Schedule 5 to that Act, and section 4 in its application to that item, commence;
- (c) appoint 1 July 1994 as the day on which the other provisions of that Act (except Schedule 2, and section 3 in its application to that Schedule) commence.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence most of the Health Legislation (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 1994 on 3 separate dates.
