**BUSINESS FRANCHISE LICENCES (TOBACCO)  
AMENDMENT ACT 1996 No 119—PROCLAMATION**

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Business Franchise Licences (Tobacco) Amendment Act 1996*, do, by this my Proclamation:

- (a) appoint 1 February 1997 as the day on which that Act, except Schedule 1 [7], commences, and
- (b) appoint 1 April 1997 as the day on which Schedule 1 [7] to that Act commences.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This Proclamation commences the *Business Franchise Licences (Tobacco) Amendment Act 1996* on 1 February 1997, except for a provision of that Act that contains offences relating to sales of tobacco to, and purchases of tobacco from, unlicensed persons. That provision is to commence on 1 April 1997.
