**LIQUOR AND REGISTERED CLUBS LEGISLATION  
AMENDMENT ACT 1997 No 155—PROCLAMATION**

(L.S.) GORDON SAMUELS, Governor.

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Liquor and Registered Clubs Legislation Amendment Act 1997*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 10 January 1998 as the day on which that Act commences, excepting:

- (a) Schedule 1 [20] to that Act, and
- (b) Schedule 2 to that Act, and
- (c) Schedule 3 [17] to that Act, in so far as it inserts clauses 56 and 57 (1) into Part 11 of Schedule 1 to the *Liquor Act 1982*, and
- (d) Schedule 4 [10] to that Act.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This Proclamation appoints 10 January 1998 as the commencement date for the *Liquor and Registered Clubs Legislation Amendment Act 1997*, other than certain provisions of that Act effecting amendments that relate to records of licensees and registered clubs and to function licences under the *Liquor Act 1982*.
