

## LIQUOR AND REGISTERED CLUBS LEGISLATION AMENDMENT ACT 1997 No 155—PROCLAMATION

## (L.S.) GORDON SAMUELS, Governor.

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Liquor and Registered Clubs Legislation Amendment Act 1997*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 April 1999 as the day on which the following provisions of that Act commence:

- (a) Schedule 2 (except for so much of Schedule 2 [7] as would insert section 23AB (3) and (4) of the *Liquor Act 1982*),
- (b) Schedule 3 [17] to the extent that it inserts clauses 56 and 57 (1) of Part 11 of Schedule 1 to the *Liquor Act 1982*.
