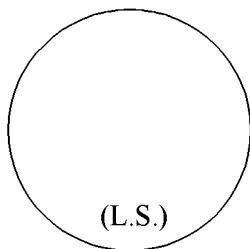

Explanatory note

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence such of the provisions of the *Building Legislation Amendment (Quality of Construction) Act 2002* as relate to the following matters:

- (a) the status and functions of certain committees established under the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*,
- (b) the subdelegation of certain functions delegated to the Director-General of the Department of Planning under the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*,
- (c) the powers of entry exercisable by a principal certifying authority under section 118A of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*,
- (d) the persons by whom penalty notices may be issued under section 127A of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*,
- (e) the penalties payable with respect to certain offences when dealt with by way of penalty notice under the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*,
- (f) the exclusion of personal liability with respect to certain acts and omissions occurring in the course of the execution of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*,
- (g) savings and transitional provisions in relation to certain amendments made to the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*,
- (h) minor law revision with respect to the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.
