Commencement

1 This Regulation commences on 22 April 1994.

Amendment

2. The Dairy Industry (Pricing) Regulation 1984 is amended:
- (a) by omitting from clause 3 (1) the definitions of “longlife cream” and “longlife extra light cream”;
 - (b) by omitting clause 4 (2) (a), (a2) and (a3).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Regulation removes references to cream and cream products from the Dairy Industry (Pricing) Regulation 1984 as a result of the omission of cream and cream products from the definition of milk in the Dairy Industry Act 1979.

This Regulation is made principally under section 56 (Prescribed provisions for fixing prices) and section 103 (1) (w) (the general regulation-making power) of that Act.
