Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 1 February 1992.

Amendment

2. The Pipelines Regulations 1968 are mended by inserting after Regulation 8 the following regulation:

Licence fees

9. For the purposes of section 34 (1) of the Act, \$308 is the prescribed amount.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The purpose of the Regulation is to prescribe \$300 as the maximum annual licence fee payable under the Pipelines Act 1967 to operate a pipeline. Formerly, the maximum amount of the fee was \$200, as specified in that Act. Consequent on the enactment of the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (No. 2) 1991, the amount is now to be prescribed by regulation.
