Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 1 August 1993.

Amendment

2. The Forestry (Short Description of Offences) Regulation 1987 is amended by inserting in Schedule 1 in appropriate order in the matter relating to the Forestry Regulation 1983 the following matter:

Clause 17 (3)—without consent, enter an area or part of an area contrary to notice

enter prohibited area

Clause 17 (3)—without consent, cause a vehicle to enter an area or part of an area contrary to notice

cause vehicle to enter prohibited area

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe the short descriptions that, by virtue of section 145B of the Justices Act 1902, are sufficient to state or describe, in any information, complaint, summons, warrant, notice, order or other document, offences under clause 17 (3) of the Forestry Regulation 1983.
