EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Proclamation commences the amendments to the Construction Safety Act 1912 in the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (No. 2) 1991. The amendments bring personnel and material hoists within the definition of "lift" for the purposes of the Act and will provide for stricter safety requirements to apply to these hoists.
