Explanatory note

The Youth Justice Advisory Committee is established by the *Young Offenders Act 1997*. The Act specifies the members of the Committee, and provides that further members may be determined in accordance with the regulations. The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Young Offenders Regulation 1997* so as to add to the Committee:

- (a) the Managing Director of the Legal Aid Commission (or a nominee of the Managing Director), and
- (b) a Magistrate nominated by the Chief Magistrate of the Local Courts.

This Regulation is made under the *Young Offenders Act 1997*, including sections 70 (1) (j) and 73 (the general regulation-making power).
