Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to ensure that the record made under section 17 of the *Young Offenders Act 1997* of a warning that is given to a child under Part 3 of that Act includes the name of the child.

This Regulation is made under the *Young Offenders Act 1997*, including section 73 (the general regulation-making power) and section 17.
