

ARCHITECTS ORDINANCE 1977

No. 29 of 1977

An Ordinance to amend the *Architects Ordinance*

[Assented to 5 July 1977]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Assembly for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Architects Ordinance 1977*. Short title
 2. The *Architects Ordinance* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Principal Ordinance
 3. Section 14 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (1) and substituting:

“(1) The Board shall authorize the registration of a person as an architect if that person satisfies the Board that he is a fit and proper person to be registered as an architect and that he—

 - (a) is a member of the Institute; or
 - (b) holds a degree or diploma in architecture conferred by—
 - (i) an institution recognized by the Royal Australian Institute of Architects or by the Architects Accreditation Council of Australia as an institution competent to confer that degree or diploma; or
 - (ii) a prescribed institution.”.

Persons entitled to registration
 4. Where, immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance, a person was registered as an architect under the Principal Ordinance, that person continues, subject to section 20 of the Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance, to be registered as an architect under the Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance.
