

ALICE SPRINGS HOSPITAL ADVISORY BOARD ORDINANCE 1963.

No. 32 of 1963.

An Ordinance to amend the *Alice Springs Hospital
Advisory Board Ordinances 1962.*

[Assented to 26th April, 1963.]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1962*, as follows:—

Short title and
citation.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Alice Springs Hospital Advisory Board Ordinance 1963.*

(2.) The *Alice Springs Hospital Advisory Board Ordinances 1962* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Alice Springs Hospital Advisory Board Ordinance 1962-1963.*

Constitution of
the Board.

2. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) by omitting paragraph (a) of sub-section (1.) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:—

“ (a) the Director of Health; ” and

(b) by omitting paragraph (d) of sub-section (1.) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:—

“ (d) three other members, one of whom shall be a private medical practitioner registered under the *Medical Practitioners Registration Ordinance 1935-1962* and residing in Alice Springs or if there is no such private medical practitioner, a medical practitioner registered under that Ordinance and residing in Alice Springs.”.
