## ALICE SPRINGS HOSPITAL ADVISORY BOARD ORDINANCE 1964.

## No. 57 of 1964.

An Ordinance to amend the Alice Springs Hospital Advisory Board Ordinance 1962–1963.

[Assented to 16th October, 1964.]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1962, as follows:—

## Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Alice Springs Hospital Advisory Board Ordinance 1964.
- (2.) The Alice Springs Hospital Advisory Board Ordinance 1962-1963 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Alice Springs Hospital Advisory Board Ordinance* 1962-1964.
- 2. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—

## Constitution of the Board.

- "4.—(1.) For the purposes of this Ordinance there shall be a Board, to be known as the Alice Springs Hospital Advisory Board, which shall consist of—
  - (a) the Medical Superintendent; and
  - (b) six other members, one of whom shall be a medical practitioner who is registered under the Medical Practitioners Registration Ordinance 1935-1962 and resides and practises as a private medical practitioner in Alice Springs or, if no such medical practitioner is available to be a member, any other medical practitioner who is so registered and resides in Alice Springs.
- "(2.) The members specified in paragraph (b) of the last preceding sub-section shall be appointed by the Administrator in Council.

- "(3.) Where an appointed member who is a medical practitioner registered under the Medical Practitioners Registration Ordinance 1935-1962 ceases to reside in Alice Springs he ceases to be a member.
- "(4.) Subject to the last preceding sub-section and to sections seven and eight of this Ordinance, an appointed member holds office for three years.
- "(5.) In this section 'appointed member' means a member appointed by the Administrator in Council.".
- 3. Section eleven of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Reports. omitting from paragraph (b) the words "Medical Superintendent" and inserting in their stead the words "Director of Health ".
- 4. Section thirteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended Minister may by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words "The Medical meeting of the Superintendent" and inserting in their stead the words "The Board. Director of Health".
