

# ALICE SPRINGS HOSPITAL ADVISORY BOARD ORDINANCE 1964.

No. 57 of 1964.

An Ordinance to amend the *Alice Springs Hospital  
Advisory Board Ordinance 1962-1963.*

[Assented to 16th October, 1964.]

**B**E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1962*, as follows:—

Short title and  
citation.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Alice Springs Hospital Advisory Board Ordinance 1964.*

(2.) The *Alice Springs Hospital Advisory Board Ordinance 1962-1963* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Alice Springs Hospital Advisory Board Ordinance 1962-1964.*

2. Section four of the Principal Ordinance is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—

Constitution of  
the Board.

“ 4.—(1.) For the purposes of this Ordinance there shall be a Board, to be known as the Alice Springs Hospital Advisory Board, which shall consist of—

(a) the Medical Superintendent; and

(b) six other members, one of whom shall be a medical practitioner who is registered under the *Medical Practitioners Registration Ordinance 1935-1962* and resides and practises as a private medical practitioner in Alice Springs or, if no such medical practitioner is available to be a member, any other medical practitioner who is so registered and resides in Alice Springs.

“ (2.) The members specified in paragraph (b) of the last preceding sub-section shall be appointed by the Administrator in Council.

“ (3.) Where an appointed member who is a medical practitioner registered under the *Medical Practitioners Registration Ordinance 1935-1962* ceases to reside in Alice Springs he ceases to be a member.

“ (4.) Subject to the last preceding sub-section and to sections seven and eight of this Ordinance, an appointed member holds office for three years.

“ (5.) In this section ‘appointed member’ means a member appointed by the Administrator in Council.”.

3. Section eleven of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the words “Medical Superintendent” and inserting in their stead the words “Director of Health”. Reports.

4. Section thirteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words “The Medical Superintendent” and inserting in their stead the words “The Director of Health”. Minister may attend any meeting of the Board.

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
