

BRANDS ORDINANCE 1974

517

No. 87 of 1974

An Ordinance to amend the *Brands Ordinance* 1928 as amended

[Reserved on 30 September 1974]

[Assented to 28 October 1974]*

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Brands Ordinance* 1974. Short title
2. The *Brands Ordinance* 1928 as amended is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Principal Ordinance
3. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.† Commencement
4. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is repealed. Parts
- 5.(1) Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is amended— Definitions
 - (a) by omitting the definition of “domesticated buffalo”; and
 - (b) by omitting from the definition of “stock” the word “domesticated”.
6. Section 14 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (4). Application to register brand
7. Section 15 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (3). Power to refuse registration
8. Sections 17B, 35A, 35B, 35C and 36B of the Principal Ordinance are repealed. Repeal of sections 17B, 35A, 35B, 35C and 36B
9. Section 42A of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting “domesticated” (wherever occurring). Delivery of unbranded animals

10. Section 42AA.(4) of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by omitting from the definition of “animals” the word “domesticated”;
- (b) by omitting from the definition of “travelling stock” the word “domesticated”; and
- (c) by omitting the definition of “travelling stock” and substituting the following definition—

“‘travelling stock’ means cattle, domesticated buffaloes or horses:

(a) driven on the hoof; or

(b) on a railway, vehicle, vessel or aircraft,

outside the boundaries of the run on which those stock are ordinarily kept or depastured.”.

11. Section 42B of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting “domesticated” (wherever occurring).
