

# CROWN LANDS ORDINANCE 1976

1017

No. 1 of 1977

An Ordinance to amend the *Crown Lands Ordinance*

[Reserved 12 November 1976]

[Assented to 16 December 1976]\*

**B**E it ordained by the Legislative Assembly for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Crown Lands Ordinance* 1976. Short title

2. The *Crown Lands Ordinance* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Principal Ordinance

3. Section 103c of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-sections (9), (10), (11) and (12) and substituting the following sub-sections: Appointment and powers of trustees of land reserved for recreation or amusement of the public, &c.

“(9) A by-law made under sub-section (8) by the trustees of any land so reserved—

- (a) shall be signed by the Chairman of the trustees;
- (b) has no effect as a law of the Territory unless it is confirmed by the Administrator in Council and notice of the confirmation is published in the *Gazette*; and
- (c) comes into operation—
  - (i) subject to sub-paragraphs (ii), (iii) and (iv), on the day on which notice of the confirmation of the by-law by the Administrator in Council is published in the *Gazette*;
  - (ii) if a later day is specified in that notice as the day upon which it comes into operation, on that later day;
  - (iii) if a later day is specified in a by-law as the day on which it comes into operation, on that later day; or
  - (iv) if a by-law, confirmed at the same time as that by-law, provides that it shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by the trustees by notice in the *Gazette*, on the day so fixed.

(9A) Subject to this section, a by-law made under this Ordinance confirmation of which as provided in sub-section (9) (b) is notified in the *Gazette* shall be deemed to be a regulation for the purposes of the *Interpretation Ordinance* and the *Regulations Publication Ordinance* as if it was made by the Administrator in Council.”
