## CROWN LANDS ORDINANCE (No. 4) 1973

## An Ordinance to amend the *Crown Lands* Ordinance 1931 as amended

[Reserved 13 July, 1973] [Assented to 30 August, 1973]\*

DE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern B Territory of Australia as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Crown Lands Ordi- short title nance (No. 4) 1973.
- 2. The Crown Lands Ordinance 1931 as amended is in this Principal Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

3. Section 48 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (1) and substituting the following sub-incompastoral least one pastoral least one pastora sections:

- "(1) The lessee under a pastoral lease the term of which commenced on or before 1 July 1953 may, at any time after the commencement of the twentieth year of that term and before the expiration of the fortieth year of that term, apply in writing to the Administrator to surrender the lease in exchange for a new pastoral lease of the whole or a specified part of the parcel of land included in the existing lease.
- "(1A) The lessee under a pastoral lease the term of which commenced or commences after 1 July 1953 may, at any time in the period during which the lease has an unexpired term of not more than 31 years and not less than 10 years, apply in writing to the Administrator to surrender the lease in exchange for a new pastoral lease of the whole or a specified part of the parcel of land included in the existing lease.".
