An Ordinance to amend the Freehold Titles *Ordinance* 1962–1971

 B^{E} it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Freehold short title Titles Ordinance 1972.

- (2.) The Freehold Titles Ordinance 1962-1971 as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the Freehold Titles Ordinance 1962-1972.
- 2. The Freehold Titles Ordinance 1962-1971 is amended by inserting after section 3 the following new section:—
- "3A.—(1.) The Minister or the Administrator may, either Delegation generally or in relation to a matter or class of matters by instrument in writing, delegate to a person or authority all or any of his powers and functions under this Ordinance (except this power of delegation).
- "(2.) A power or function so delegated may be exercised or performed by the delegate in accordance with the instrument of delegation.
- "(3.) A delegation under this section is revocable at will and does not prevent the exercise of a power or function by the Minister or the Administrator.".
