

NATIONAL PARKS AND GARDENS ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1974

No. 59 of 1974

An Ordinance to amend the *National Parks and Gardens Ordinance 1959* as amended

[Assented to 15 October 1974]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *National Parks and Gardens Ordinance (No. 2) 1974*. Short title

2. The *National Parks and Gardens Ordinance 1959* as amended is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Principal Ordinance

3.(1) Section 22(1) of the Principal Ordinance is amended— By-law making procedure

(a) by omitting sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a);
and

(b) by omitting paragraph (b).

(2) Section 22 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-sections (2), (3) and (4) and substituting the following sub-sections:

“(2) A by-law under this Ordinance—

(a) has no effect as a law of the Territory unless it is confirmed by the Administrator in Council; and

(b) comes into operation on the day on which notice of the confirmation of the by-law by the Administrator in Council is published in the *Gazette* or, if a later day is specified in that notice as the day on which it comes into operation, on that later day.

“(3) Subject to this section, by-laws under this Ordinance confirmation of which as provided by sub-section (2) is notified in the *Gazette* shall be deemed to be regulations for the purposes

of the *Interpretation Ordinance* and the *Regulations Publication Ordinance* as if they were made by the Administrator in Council.”.

(3) The amendments of the Principal Ordinance made by this Ordinance do not affect the continuance in force of by-laws in force immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance but any such by-law may be amended or repealed by by-laws made under the Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance.
