An Ordinance to amend the Prisons Ordinance 1950-1968

[Assented to 11 April, 1969]

B E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern

1.--(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Prisons Short title and citation Ordinance 1969.

(2.) The Prisons Ordinance 1950-1968 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Prisons Ordinance 1950-1969.

2. Section 11A of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Prison Officers inserting after sub-section (6A.) the following sub-sections:-

"(6B.) A nominated member who desires to resign his

office shall deliver a written resignation to the Administrator.

"(6c.) An available elected member who desires to resign his appointment as an available elected member shall deliver a written resignation to the Administrator.

"(6D.) The resignation of a nominated member or available elected member becomes effective when it is received by the Administrator.".
