

## PUBLIC SERVICE ORDINANCE 1965

No. 14 of 1966

An Ordinance to amend the *Public Service Ordinance*  
1928-1964

[Reserved 8th April, 1965.]

[Assented to 5th May, 1966.]\*

**B**E it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act* 1910-1962, as follows:—

Short title  
and citation.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Public Service Ordinance* 1965.

(2.) The *Public Service Ordinance* 1928-1964 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Public Service Ordinance* 1928-1965.

Commence-  
ment.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator in Council. †

Departments  
and Branches.

3. Section eight of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (2.) and inserting the following sub-section in its stead:—

“ (2.) The Department of the Administrator shall consist of the following branches:—

- (a) the Education Branch;
- (b) the Police Branch;
- (c) the Prisons Branch; and
- (d) the Fire Services Branch.”.

Appeal Board.

4. Section twenty-four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting paragraph (c) of sub-section (1.) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:—

“ (c) in the case of—

- (i) an appeal by an officer of the Police Branch, an officer of the Police Branch elected as a representative by the members of that Branch;

- (ii) an appeal by an officer of the Prisons Branch, an officer of the Prisons Branch elected by the members of that Branch;
  - (iii) an appeal by an officer of the Fire Services Branch, an officer of the Fire Services Branch elected by the members of that Branch; or
  - (iv) an appeal by an officer of the Department of the Legislative Council, an officer of the Department of the Legislative Council elected by the members of that Department.”.
