An Ordinance to amend the *Registration Ordinance*

[Assented to 8 September 1976]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Assembly for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Registration Ordinance 1976*. Short title
2. The *Registration Ordinance* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Principal Ordinance
3. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.* Commencement
4. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (1) and substituting— Registrar-General and Deputy Registrars-General

“(1) There shall be a Registrar-General for the Northern Territory appointed by the Administrator in Council.

“(1A) The Administrator may appoint such persons as he thinks necessary to be Deputy Registrars-General.”.
5. Section 6(2) of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting “, an Acting Registrar-General” (last occurring). Powers and duties of Registrar-General
6. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is amended— Declaration to be made on taking office

 - (a) by omitting “Every Registrar-General, Deputy Registrar-General, and Acting Registrar-General” and substituting “Every Registrar-General and Deputy Registrar-General”;
 - (b) by omitting “the Judge of the Northern Territory” and substituting “a Judge of the Supreme Court of the Northern Territory of Australia”; and
 - (c) by omitting from the declaration “, or Acting Registrar-General, as the case may be”.
