

WELFARE ORDINANCE 1963.

No. 38 of 1963.

An Ordinance to amend the *Welfare Ordinance*
1953-1961.

[Assented to 23rd May, 1963.]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act* 1910-1962, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Welfare Ordinance* 1963.

(2.) The *Welfare Ordinance* 1953-1961 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Welfare Ordinance* 1953-1963.

Persons not to
enter reserves
without
authority.

2. Section forty-five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after paragraph (b) the following paragraph:—

“(ba) he is the member of the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory elected for the electorate in which the reserve, or a part of the reserve, is situated;”.

Persons not to
enter land of
institution with-
out authority.

3. Section forty-seven of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after paragraph (b) the following paragraph:—

“(ba) he is the member of the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory elected for the electorate in which the reserve, or a part of the reserve, is situated;”.

Persons not to
enter camping
ground without
authority.

4. Section fifty-one of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after paragraph (e) the following paragraph:—

“(ea) he is the member of the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory elected for the electorate in which the reserve, or a part of the reserve, is situated;”.
