Regulations under the Abattoirs and Slaughtering Ordinance 1955-1968

AMENDMENTS OF THE ABATTOIRS AND SLAUGHTERING REGULATIONS†

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on a date to be fixed Commencement by the Administrator by notice in the Gazette.‡

- 2. Regulation 3 of the Abattoirs and Slaughtering Regulations is repeal of Regulation 3.
- 3. Regulation 9 of the Abattoirs and Slaughtering Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—
- "9. The areas specified in the Third Schedule are Licensed Abattoirs Areas." Licensed Abattoirs Areas.
- 4. Regulation 46 of the Abattoirs and Slaughtering Regulations is repealed.
- 5. The Second Schedule to the Abattoirs and Slaughtering Regulations Repeal of Second Schedule
- 6. The Third Schedule to the Abattoirs and Slaughtering Regulations is Third Schedule repealed and the following schedule inserted in its stead:—
