Regulations 1983, No. 4*

By-laws under the *Local Government Act*

The Alice Springs Town Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by the *Local Government Act* and in accordance with section 350(3) of the Act, at a meeting held on the twentieth day of December, 1982, hereby makes the following By-laws.

ALICE SPRINGS (PARKING) BY-LAWS

1. CITATION

These By-laws may be cited as the Alice Springs (Parking) By-laws.

2. STOPPING AND PARKING

Section 36D (other than sub-section (12A)(b)) of the *Traffic Act* and regulation 33B of the Traffic Regulations made under that Act, with the necessary changes and as varied by by-law 3, are adopted and shall apply in the Municipality of Alice Springs as if they were contained in this by-law.

3. INTERPRETATION

(1) For the purposes of these By-laws and section 36D of the *Traffic Act*, as adopted by by-law (1) -

"motor vehicle" includes a motor car, motor carriage, motor cycle, motor lorry, motor omnibus, motor tractor or other vehicle propelled wholly or partly by a volatile spirit or by steam, gas, oil or electricity, a bicycle within the meaning of the *Traffic Act*, an animal drawn vehicle, and a trailer at any time attached to any of them, but does not include a vehicle used on a railway;

"park" has the same meaning as in section 354A of the Act;

Alice Springs (Parking) By-laws

"public street" means a road;

"traffic sign" has the same meaning as "official traffic sign" in section 354B of the Act.

(2) Where on a traffic sign erected, placed or displayed by the Council under or for the purposes of these By-laws there is a reference to a motor vehicle of a particular kind and the words used to describe the motor vehicle do not have a defined meaning in or for the purposes of section 36D of the *Traffic Act* but are defined in the *Motor Vehicles Act* those words shall have the same meaning as they have in the *Motor Vehicles Act*.

4. ERECTION, &c., OF TRAFFIC SIGNS

For the purposes of these By-laws the Council may erect, place or display such traffic signs as it thinks fit.

5. OFFENCE

A person who contravenes or fails to comply with these By-laws is guilty of an offence.

Penalty: \$100.

6. APPLICATION OF SECTION 354A

Section 354A of the Act applies to and in relation to an offence against these By-laws.
