“Class as which Building is to be used (Applicant must here nominate from the following list of classes of buildings the appropriate class as which the proposed building will be used):—

#### Classes of Buildings\*

- Class I. — House
- Class II. — Flats
- Class III. — Residential Building (not being a class I, II, or IV building)
- Class IV. — Dwelling attached to a class V, VI, VII or VIII building
- Class V. — Office Building
- Class VI. — Shop
- Class VII. — Warehouse
- Class VIII. — Factory
- Class IX. — Public Building
- Class X. — Out Building.”.
